It started with shelter volunteers noticing the same story over and over: So many cats coming in were outdoor, unowned, and part of a bigger, unseen crisis.

Their insight led us to a truth we couldn't ignore—
The community cat problem was growing, and the shelter system wasn't built to fix
it.

P Opportunity

By listening to the people on the ground, we shifted our focus to prevention. We launched a targeted TNR program and met the need where it started: in the neighborhoods. This one simple act led us to years later having our own clinic.

RESCUE TRAIN PROGRAMS



We rescue dogs, cats and farm animals and find them loving homes. In addition, we provide rehoming assistance to the public, Good Samaritans and other rescue groups.



KEEP YOUR PET PROJECT

We provide resources to senior, veteran, low-income and pet owners experiencing homelessness, so they never have to surrender their pet to a shelter.



PET PANTRY

There are many areas of Los Angeles where people live in poverty and struggle to make ends meet. We provide pet food and supplies to pet owners in crisis.



RESCUE TRAIN HOTLINE

As part of our community outreach, we operate a hotline for pet owners to obtain affordable referrals to veterinary care, spay/neuter services, and other valuable resources.



SPAY/NEUTER CLINIC

We offer free and low-cost spay and neuter because it is the most effective way to decrease pet overpopulation and help animals live longer, healthier lives.




